- 3. Questionnaire Survey w.r.t. plastic usage and waste disposal practices at various levels, i.e., in commercial areas (eatery and non-eatery units/ shops), residential areas (households of different income groups), public and social events (exhibitions, fairs, wedding functions etc.)
- 4. Per capita generation of plastic waste.
- 5. Plastic waste due to tourism in Delhi
- 6. Brand Audit of plastic waste in Delhi
- 7. Alternatives to plastics and waste reduction pathways
- 8. Recycling of plastics in Delhi
- 9. Reuse and disposal
- 10. Conclusions and Policy Recommendations
